

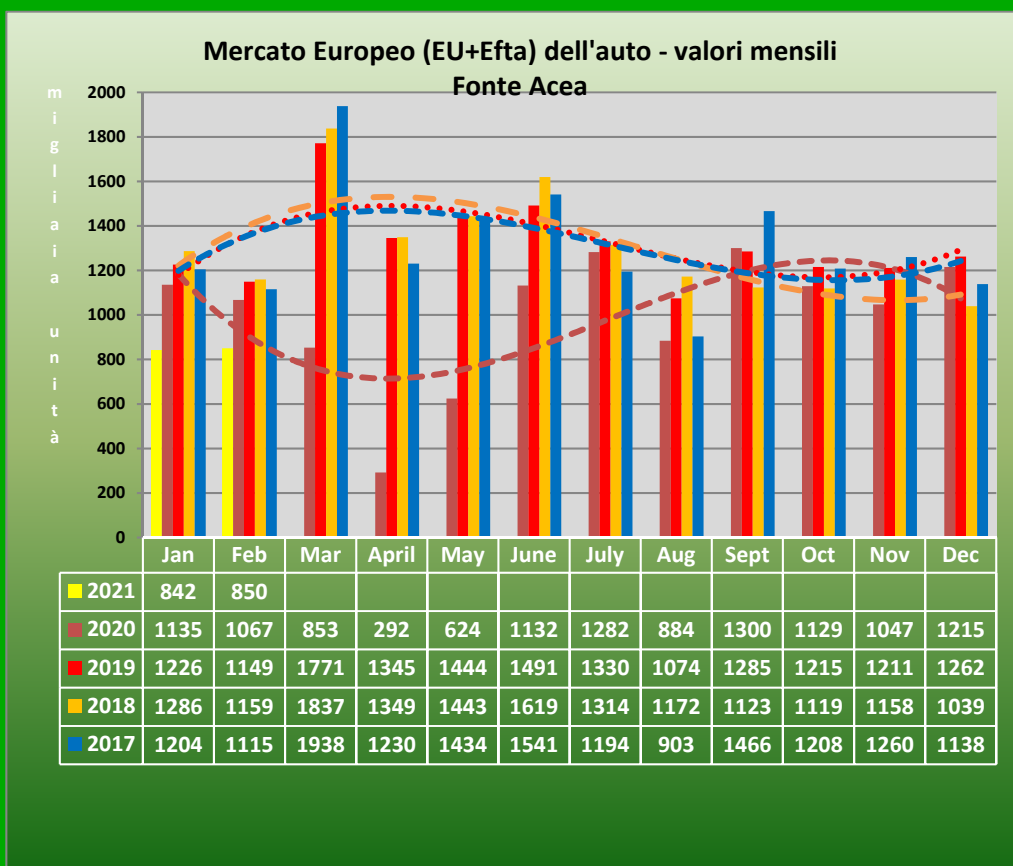

European Car Market - February 2021 registrations

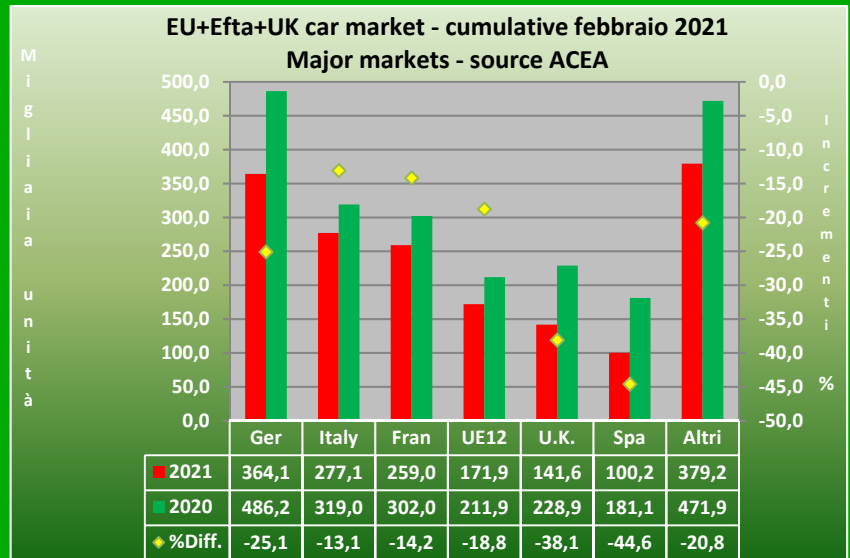
The decline of the European car market (EU + EFTA + UK) continues in February: -20.3% in the month. In the two-month total, the market fell by 23.1%.



According to data released by ACEA, the Association of European manufacturers, registrations of new cars in the EU + EFTA + UK area in february amounted to 850,170 units against 1,066,172 units in the same month last year. The two-month period closes

with a decrease of 23.1% to 1,693,059 registered units, with a loss of approximately 500,000 units. During the month, the greatest losses were recorded in Spain (-38.4%), in Great Britain (-35.5%), in France (-20.9%), in Germany (-19%), followed by Italy (-12.3%), the EU12 (-10.7%) and the EFTA area (-9.2%).

The situation of the major markets in the two-month total appears from the table alongside. In particular, Italy gains the second position ahead of France and Great Britain.
