



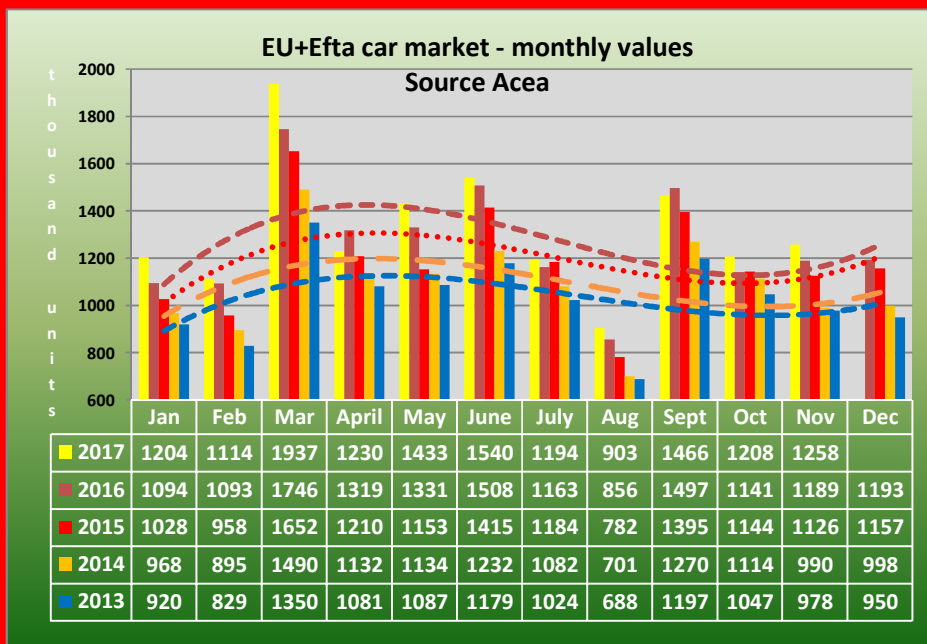

European Car Market (EU+Efta): Car registrations in November 2017

The car market in the EU + Efta continues to grow: in November: + 5.8% with 1,258,220 units registered. In the first eleven months cumulated registrations grew by 4% over the same period last year to 14,493,361 units.

Increase in volume and share of the FCA Group, which rose from 6.6% to 6.8% in the first eleven months.

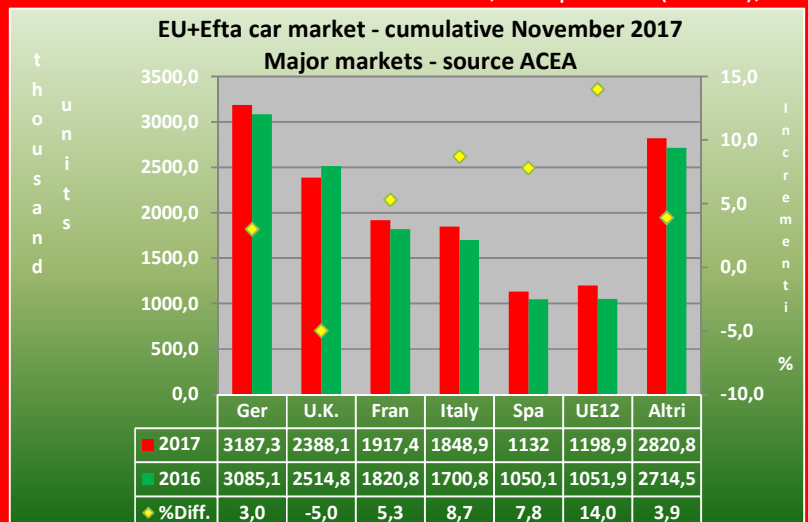


Good performances in the month of Spain (+12.4%), France (+10.3%), EU12 (+10.3%) and Germany (+9.4%). Italy grew by 6.8% and the Efta area by 2.4%. The UK market continues to lose, falling by 11.2% in the month.

In the cumulative of the first eleven months, the EU12 rises by 14% [mainly due to Romania (+14.6%), Poland (+17.4%) and Hungary (+21.4%)], followed by Italy with +8.7%, Spain (+7.8%),

France with +5.3% and Germany (+3%). Britain loses 5%. The EFTA area gains 1.2%.

On average the increase in registrations in most of the rest of Europe. As already for the past few months, Great Britain still remains largely in second place and Italy is close to third place, still the prerogative of France, for a few thousand units in the ranking of the major European countries.
