

## Italian car market - January 2023

## Clear improvement in January (+19%) of the Italian car market




Secondo l'Anfia According to Anfia " "Positive opening in 2023 for the car market (+19%) - which follows the double-digit increases recorded in the last three months of 2022 - also thanks to one more working day compared to January 2022 (21 working days against 20) and compared with a heavy drop in the first month of 2022 (-19.7%) - says Paolo Scudieri, President of ANFIA.

For its part Unrae. states: "UNRAE CONFIRMS FORECAST FOR 2023 WITH 1.4 MILLION CARS (+6.3%)CRISCI: Good decrees for charging infrastructures but we need to speed up the process of those

which provide concessions for purchase and installation by private individuals.


Unemployment is stable at 7.8% in December; it had been 8.8% in December 2021. Youth unemployment



fell

to 22.1%; it was 26.3% last year.

As regards the automotive sector as a whole, according to preliminary data from Anfia, in November the domestic production of cars increased by 7.6% on November last year. In the first eleven months it rose by 4.4%



The share of gas vehicles was 10.6%. It was 9.5% last year. Together with electric and hybrid vehicles, the share of alternative-oil traction vehicles was 54.5% in December, thanks exclusively to electric vehicles. In December, diesel's share was 19.1%. Gasoline vehicles stood at 26.4%.
