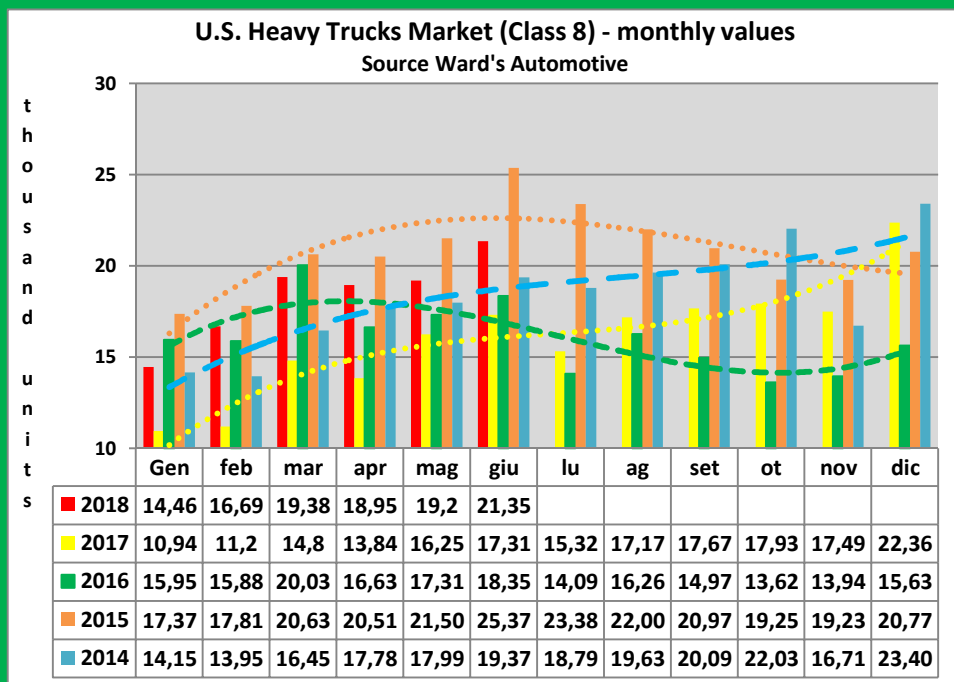




U.S. Market for Heavy Trucks (Class 8) in June 2018

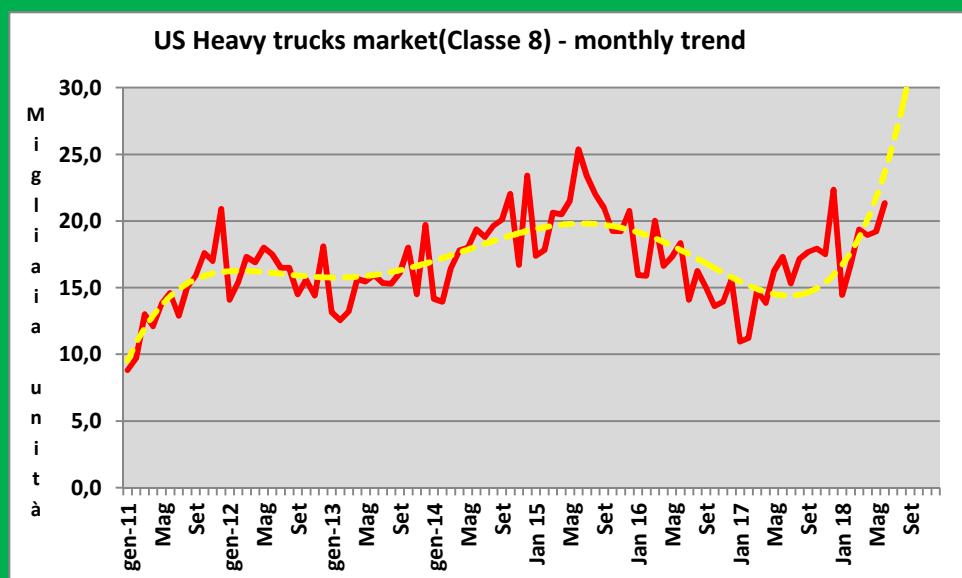

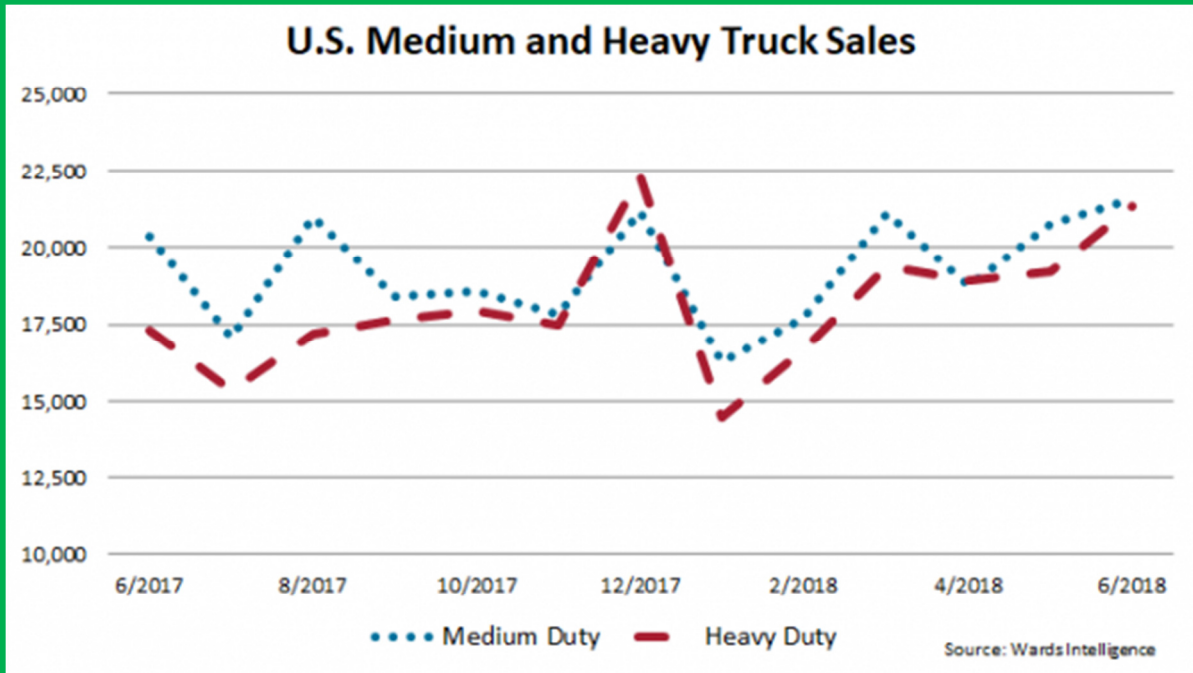
Brilliant sales results for heavy trucks (class 8) in June, increased by 11.2% compared to last month and by 23.3% compared to the same month last year.



According to preliminary data from Ward's Automotive, with 21351 units, sales of Class 8 vehicles in June rose by 11.2% compared to May, and by 23.3% compared to June last year. In the first semester cumulated sales amounted to 110,025 units, 30.5% more than the same period last year.

Orders continue to show a progressive increase over the previous year, with a volume of over 43,200 units (+ 20% over May), 133% more than the same month last year. According to Don Ake, Vice President of the Act Research, production capacity remains at its best and many months are still expected to clear the gap that continues to increase due to the high demand for trucks linked to the good performance of the economy.
