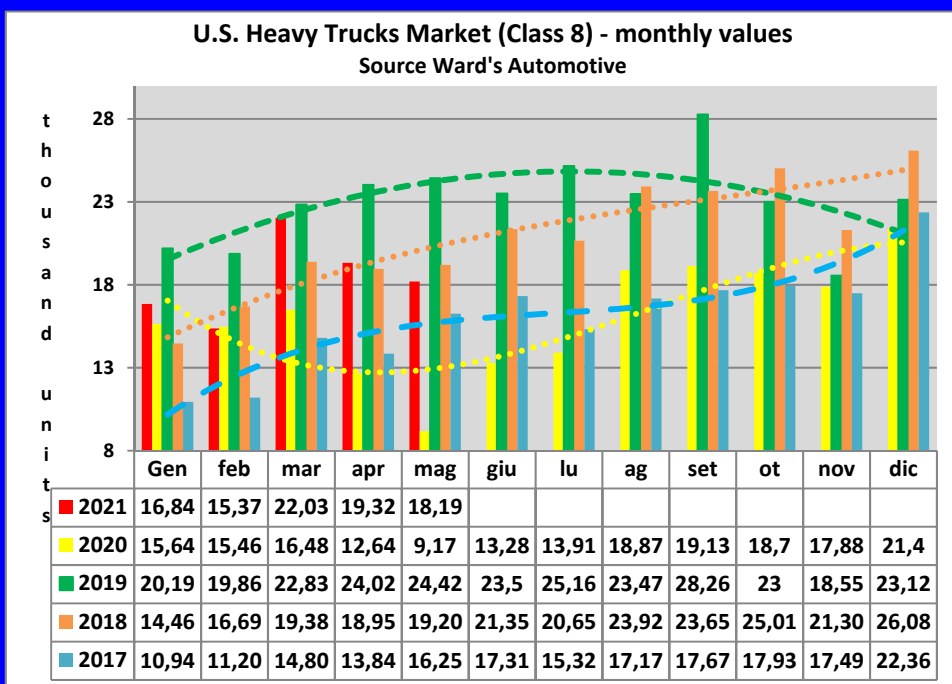




## US Heavy Truck Market, May 2021 sales

Torino, June 11, 2021

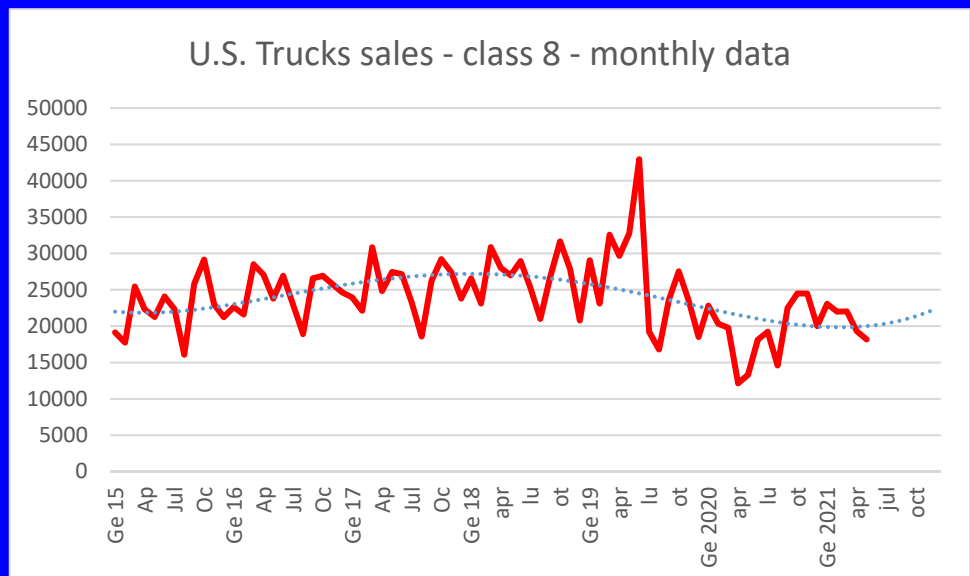
Sales of heavy duty vehicles (class 8) double in May compared to last year.



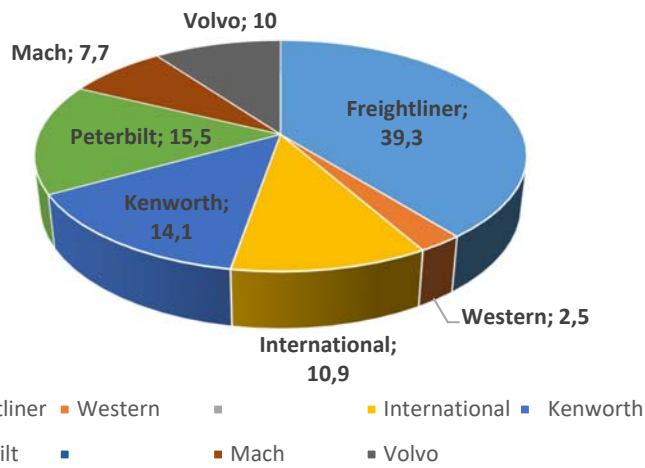
According to preliminary data from Ward's Automotive, as reported by Transport Topics, with 18,187 units the sales of class 8 vehicles in May fell by 5.8% compared to April, but rose by 98.4% compared to last year in full pandemic crisis. In the first 5 months cumulative sales grew by 32.2% compared to last year with 91,714 units sold compared to 69,379 last year.

From a heavy vehicle demand perspective Class 8 orders cooled in May, reflecting the filling of build slots this year and OEMs' reticence to begin taking orders for 2022.

FTR reports preliminary figures of 23,600 Class 8 orders, down 32% from April but still totaling 420,000 units over the past 12 months.
