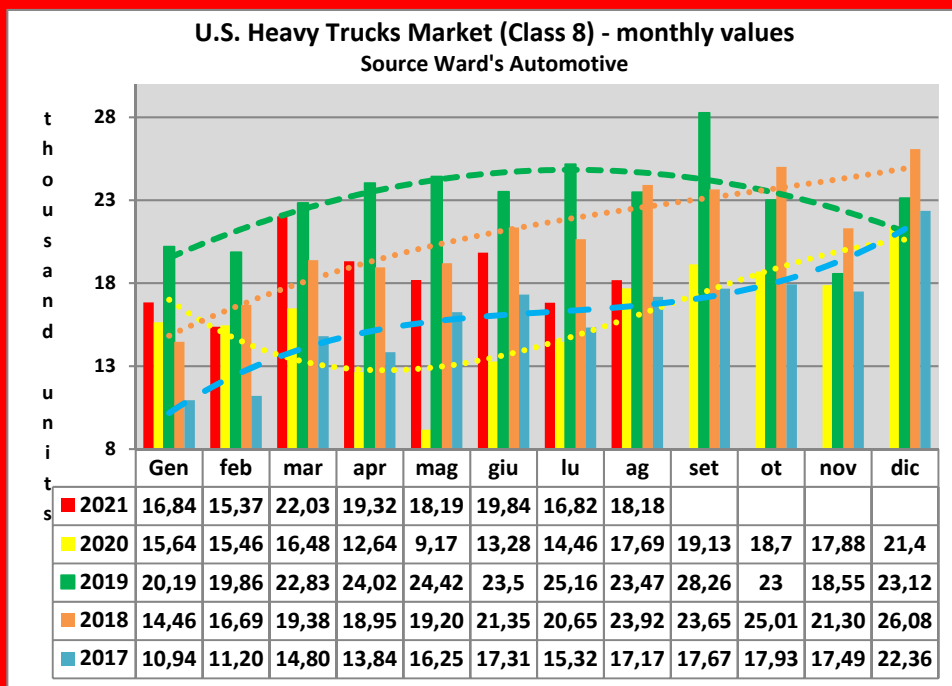




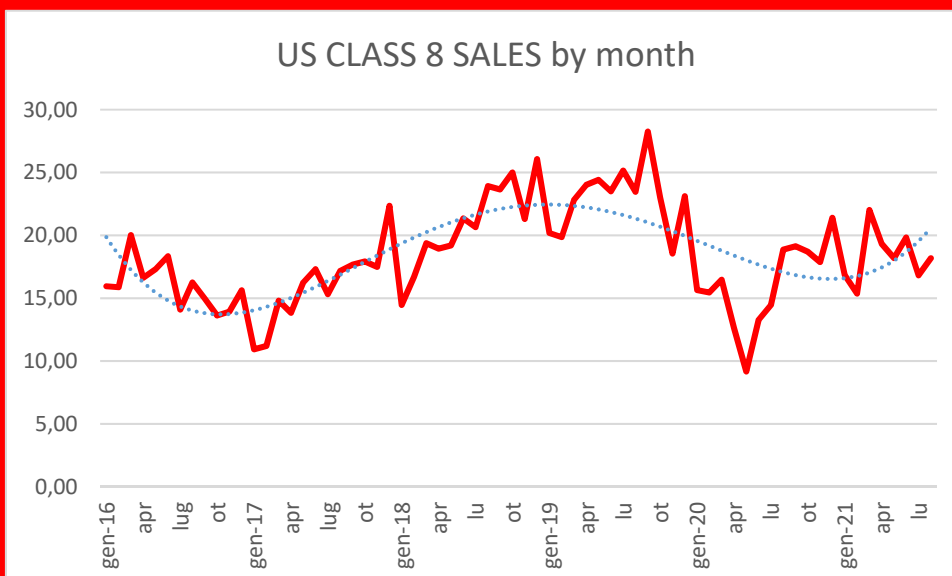
US Heavy Truck Market, sales in August

Torino, september 15, 2021

Slight recovery in August (+ 8.1%) in sales of heavy vehicles (class 8), and + 2.8% compared to last year.

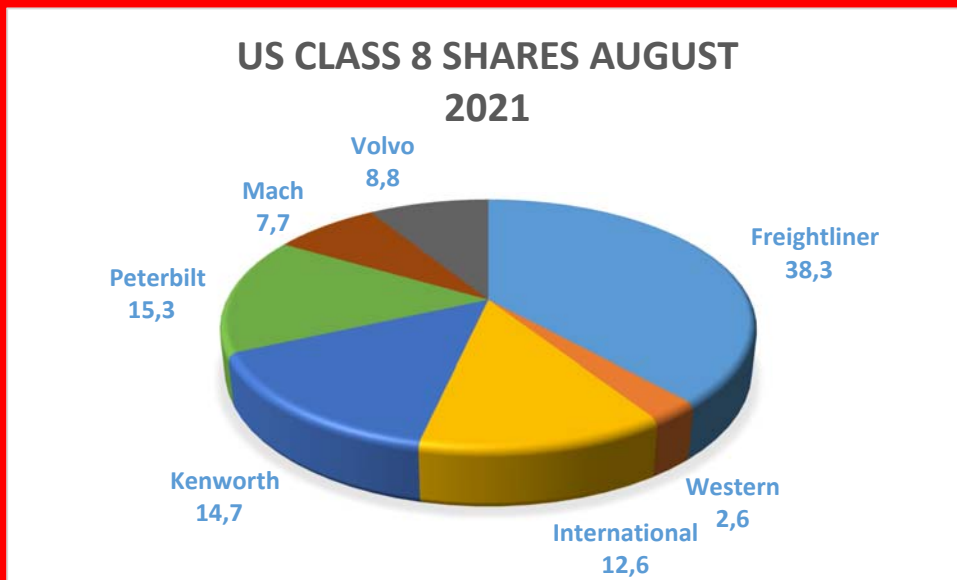
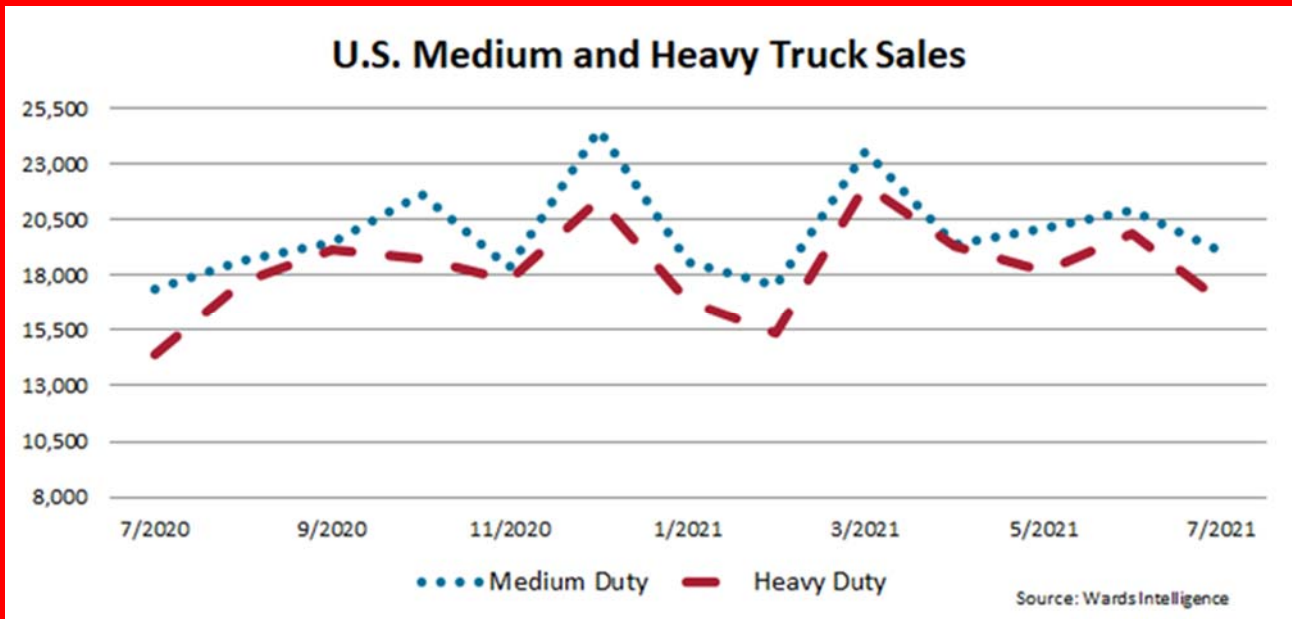


According to preliminary data from Ward's Automotive, as reported by Transport Topics, with 18176 units, sales of class 8 vehicles in August increased by 8.1% compared to July and by 2.8% compared to last year in the middle of the pandemic crisis. In the cumulative of the first 8 months, sales grew by 27.7% compared to last year with 146,552 units sold compared to 114795 last year.



North American Class 8 orders in August nearly hit 37,000, marking a five-month high with demand showing no signs of abating "In this reality we are in today, where customers keep asking for trucks and have a hard time getting them, it's interesting to see that many of them sign up

and say "Yes, I want trucks, please," ACT Vice President Steve Tam said.
