


US Heavy Truck market, sales in December 2021

Torino, January 14, 2022


Leap forward in December (+ 49.8% over November) in sales of heavy vehicles (class 8), with 24,716 registrations, the highest value for the year.




According to preliminary data from Ward's Automotive, with 24,716 units the sales of class 8 vehicles grew by 15.5% compared to last year in the middle of the pandemic crisis.


In the total for the year, sales grew by 15.6% compared to last year with 221,889 units sold Preliminary orders totaled 22,800 units. Class 8 orders in December were the second weakest

of the year. Production remained constrained by difficult supply chain, which continued make truck manufacturers very careful about adding new orders to the pipeline, **ACT** Research reported.



In the total heavy truck market (from class 4 to 8) sales in December increased by 6.3%. The year ended with an increase of 12.7% over 2020.
